We have a request from the Marion County Communities In School organization. They would like some data on the students that participate in our district's after school activities.

Our after school programs are funded through grants that Linda Ogden, the Marion County Communities In Schools director, writes. Most of our after school programs would not be possible without the financial help of the CIS grant money. The PATHS program is totally funded through the CIS grants.

CIS would like to track the students that participate in the after school programs for school attendance and grades. Those students will be assigned number for tracking purposes. It will be done anonymously. The data that CIS needs for its grant writing will be submitted in percentages of change for the after school population.

Permission slips that go home from now on for after school programs will include a second signed permission that will enable CIS to track your child. *If that permission is not signed your child will still be able to participate in that after school activity.* Those parents that have children in bike, guitar clubs, and CHUMS can expect a CIS tracking permission form to be coming home in the next week.
